Similarly, besides their domain the teachers are encouraged to engage themselves in inter departmental and inter disciplinary research activities.


Head of the college i.e. Principal is aware that exploration and reflection are crucial for any academician to be effective in his/her job. Quality research outcome is beneficial for the discipline/society/industry/region and the nation. As sharing of knowledge especially theory and practical findings of research is essential wide publicity is given by Principal through various media. The publication of research findings enhances the quality of teaching. The Management promptly acclaims research efforts of the teacher and appreciation certificates are given and awards are conferred on teachers who successfully complete their research projects.

Taking into consideration the importance of research the Management has laid down certain rules and norms as a policy. The rules and the norms are given below:

- Each department of the college shall ensure that at least 03 research papers of the academic employees in the department are published in International Journals and at least 02 research papers in National Journals are published every academic year.
- Head of the Department shall ensure that academic employee in his/her department participates in National/ International conference and present research paper in the conferences. It is expected that minimum 05 research papers are presented by academic employee of each department in every academic year.
- Head of the college shall ensure that the academic employees of all departments get adequate opportunities of presentation of research papers.
- An academic employee who prepares and presents a research papers is allowed to have a co-author and he/she is also allowed to be the co-author of research paper written by another academic employee.

- If the research proposal of a teacher is found to be essential, in order and approved by the Management, the Management shall give the amount of Rs. 50,000/- towards the Seed Money to the research scholar in order to enable him/her to initiate his/her research work.
- An academic employee who presents research paper in any seminar or conference shall be entitled to receive the amount as stated in Human Resource Policy per paper for a research paper in International Conference and the amount per paper presented in National Conference. Similarly, additional incentives may be given by the Management to the research scholar.
- The amount towards incentives shall be equally divided in case of joint authorship.
- The time to be availed of for research during working hours shall be as per the provision made by University Grants Commission (UGC)/All Indian Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi.
- Plagiarism is not allowed in research work. If it is observed that a research paper is replete with plagiarism the researcher concern shall be dealt with as per the policy framed in respect of plagiarism by the Management. If the researcher is found guilty of plagiarism he/she shall be punished in accordance with the quantum of the offence as mentioned in the policy of plagiarism.
