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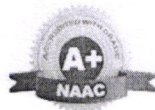

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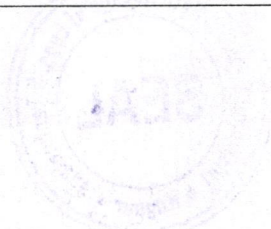

	<p>Discussion held and Suggestions given –</p> <p>4.4.1 Prof. Anup Gade presented the syllabus approved by respective BoS of all the UG and PG programmes. He also informed the gathering that the links of the syllabus was already shared with all the respected members for their kind perusal.</p>
	<p>Resolution 4: The Academic Council has resolved to approve the scheme and syllabus of all UG 5th semester, 3rd semester CSE(DS), and 1st year of M. Tech. EVT, AE.</p>
	<p>Agenda 5: Incentive Marks to be offered to the students</p>
AC.4.5	<p>Discussion held and Suggestions given :</p> <p>4.5.1 Dr.Tushar Shende discussed about the cap of maximum number of events attempted and corresponding marks distribution. He suggested to have some fix number of credits per semester like 0.5 credits can be offered and activity list can be defined before commencement of the semester so that students can participate in these activities and earned credits. He added that this will suffice all the purposes.</p> <p>4.5.2 Dr. O.G. Kakade told that it is not mandatory for the students to opt for incentive based activity if we have made it compulsory or given an additional marks which will be the part of CGPA, some students will not participate in the activity. Is there any separate head for considering incentive grade and how incentive marks consider for calculation of CGPA?, He added.</p> <p>4.5.3 Dr. O.G. Kakde suggested that rational for giving incentive marks must be satisfied and those students who have not participated in activity then no benefit of incentive marks to be given to these students.During discussion Dr. S.W. Rajurkar added that incentive marks for industry oriented project cannot be added as it's a part of your curriculum. Prof. Gade tried to justify the reason behind keeping industry oriented project under incentive category by saying that it will also cover mini and micro project. Dr. O.G. Kakde furhter added that don't make system complex and complicated for assessment. He further suggested giving name as activity based learning instead of incentive marks.</p> <p>4.5.4 Prof. Anup Gade ensured the gathering that the decision of incentive marks will be finalized after the detail analysis and will be shared with all the respected members for their kind perusal.</p>

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

He suggested that course namely Communication for Personality Development should have theory paper for evaluation. He suggested to change the course category of Principle of Electrical Engineering and Engineering, and Computer Graphics for the respective branches.</p> <p>4.6.2 Dr. S. W. Rajurkar asked that how the branches are divided into two groups on which basis it has done? Prof. Gade explained that core branches include ME, CE, EE, AE, and BT whereas pool of soft branches include CSE, IT, DS, ECE as they have similar kind of requirement for courses.</p> <p>4.6.3 Prof. Anup Gade gave information and explained the details scheme of 1st and 2nd semester as per the guideline of Govt. of Maharashtra on implementation of NEP-2020 from session 2023-24.</p> <p>4.6.4 Dr. O.G. Kakde told that there is very little scope for changes in course category in the scheme given by Govt. of Maharashtra on implementation of NEP-2020.</p> <p>4.6.5 Prof. Anup Gade informed the gathering that the scheme from first year to final year will be finalized as per the guideline of Govt. of Maharashtra on implementation of NEP-2020 very soon and will be shared with all the respected members for their kind perusal.</p>
