AC.5.4	<p>Agenda 4: Incentive Marks to be offered to the students</p> <p>Discussion held and Suggestions given :</p> <p>5.4.1 Prof. Anup Gade presented the proposed structure and categories of incentive marks to be offered to the students.</p> <p>5.4.2 Dr. Tushar Shende queried about the batch for which the proposal has been made. He suggested that publication in journals should not be made compulsory for undergraduate students. He informed that the incentive policies in RTMNU suggests only 3 categories namely sports, NSS and participation in cultural activities for which incentive marks are awarded to the students. Paper publications and research are not considered for incentive marks. He suggested that the structure of incentive marks should be revised as per RTMNU guidelines.</p> <p>5.4.3 Dr. Kakde stated that CGPA is awarded for academic activities so it should not consider the marks earned through incentives.</p> <p>5.4.4 Dr. Shende informed that incentives for sports, NSS and participation in cultural activities are considered in CGPA by RTMNU.</p> <p>5.4.5 Dr. Kakde suggested that, we may introduce alternative courses of 3 credits.</p> <p>5.4.6 Mr. Manish Sanghavi informed that he may provide experts for alternative courses such as welding technology, lean manufacturing.</p> <p>5.4.7 It has advised that the institute should follow parent university guidelines so that no further issues will be raised.</p> <p>Resolution 4:It has been resolved that the institute shall prepare the scheme of incentive resembling with RTMNU.</p>

K. Awari suggested that responses of major/minor projects should be analyzed by each department.</p>
