

Discussion held & Suggestions given-

- 6.3.1 Prof. Anup Gade informed the august house that the institute has adopted the structure given by government of Maharashtra in its GR dated July 04, 2023 for preparation of all the schemes with minor modifications in it wherever required.
- 6.3.2 Dr. Pratik Ghutke, HoD Electrical Engineering Department has presented schemes of UG, and two PG programmes namely IPS, and EVT.
- 6.3.3 During presentation Dr. Tushar Shende raised a concern about CIE marks distribution for 50 marks course which is having distribution as CT-1 for 07 marks, CT-2 for 07 marks, CA for 06 marks, and ESE for 30 marks. Dr. Shende was of the opinion of making it as 15 +5 for CT+CA respectively wherein Prof. Gade replied that the institute has kept the ratio same as that of 100 marks course. Moreover Prof. Nadir Hussain told that it is more feasible to calculate CA marks as it is distributed equally for all the three units in the range of 02 marks per unit.
- 6.3.4 Prof. Gade pointed towards the issue of attainment calculation if we change the ratio, wherein Dr. Shende suggested to take the opinion of Dr. G.K. Awari.
- 6.3.5 Dr. Awari has asked about the ratio of marks distribution and confirms that keeping ratio similar is always a better option and suggested to go ahead with presented marking scheme.
- 6.3.6 Dr. Awari asked HoD EE regarding the approval of courses of EVT programmes, Dr. Ghutke answered that he has taken approval of courses from relevant BoS, like for the courses relevant to Mechanical Engineering (ME), approval is taken from ME BoS and same is the case with courses related to ECE.
- 6.3.7 Dr. Tushar Shende suggested for opting the uniform credits to the MOOCs courses to HoD EE.
- 6.3.8 HoD Mechanical Engineering presented schemes of UG and PG as recommend by BoS.
- 6.3.9 HoD Civil Engineering, Dr. Snehal Abhyankar presented UG and PG schemes wherein Mr. Sanghvi has raised certain concerns about some courses wherein he asked, whether the industry required courses are added by the department? Dr. Abhyankar informed Mr. Sanghvi and other members that her department has made the scheme looking in to the needs of industry.
- 6.3.10 Prof. Gade informed to the august house that the institute has conducted curriculum validation workshop by inviting two industry personnel for
